POTTED INDOOR PLANTS	
CLASS	Description
1	African Violets – one crown, single or double flowered
2	Any potted plant, not listed, in bloom, pot not over 8” in diameter
3	Foliage plant in 8” pot or smaller
4	Any one cactus or succulent – pot not over 8” in diameter
5	Collection of 5 or more cacti and/or succulents planted in container not over 10” in diameter
CUT FLOWERS	
6	Anemones c.v.a. - 3 stems
7	English daisies c.v.a. - 5 stems
8	Pansies or violas – 3 cuts or stems
9	Primroses, one flower on one stem c.v.a.- 5 stems
10	Polyantha Primroses (multiple flowers on 1 stem) – 3 stems
11	Garden Violets c.v.a.- 5 stems
12	Any cut flower, not listed – 5 stems NOTE- not shrubs.
13	Any cut flower 16” or more in height – 1 stem
FLOWERING BULBS	
14	Tulips c.v.a. - single, one vase- 5 blooms
15	Tulips c.v.a. - double, one vase – 3 blooms
16	Any other tulip – 3 blooms
17	A vase of any variety of narcissi c.v.a. - 5 blooms
18	King Alfred Daffodil – 1 bloom
19	Any other dwarf variety variety narcissi - 3 stems, (i.e.Jonquilla, Tazetta, poeticus, Tet-a-Tet)
20	Any spring bulb not listed – 3 stems
21	Hyacinth – any colour – 1 stem
22	Muscari, white (grape hyacinth) – 3 stems
23	Muscari, blue single – 3 stems
24	Scilla (bluebell) c.v.a. - 3 stems
FLORAL ART – NOVICE	
25	REACH FOR THE SKY – a Vertical design
26	SUNNY DAYS – A Round exhibit using spring flowers
27	GARDEN TREASURES – A Horizontal design
FLORAL ART – ADVANCED	
28	SMALL, SMALL, SMALL WORLD – a Miniature design 5”
29	DAZZLING DIAMONDS – your interpretation
30	TIMES OF PROMISE – an exhibit in the Oriental style
31	CURVACIOUS – A Hogarth Curve design
