CLASS	Description
1	Red Rose – 1 bloom
2	Pink Rose – 1 bloom
3	Peace Rose, any colour – 1 bloom
4	Container of Roses – each a different variety – 5 blooms
5	Hybrid Tea rose – 1 bloom, any colour except Red or Pink
6	Rambler or Climbing Rose – 1 lateral
7	Floribunda Rose – 1 cut
8	Miniature Rose – 1 cut
9	Shrub or Carpet Rose – 1 cut minimum length 8”
10	Sweet Peas c.v.a. – 3 stems (not perennial variety)
11	Any other Annual – 1 stem
12	Any other Perennial not listed NOT ROSES – 3 stems
13	Foxglove – 1 cut
14	Peony – 1 bloom
15	Sedum – 3 stems
16	Clematis – 3 blooms floating
17	Astrantia c.v.a. – 3 cuts
18	Hosta leaf 10” and over (large) – 1 leaf in water
19	Hosta leaf 6-9” (medium) – 1 leaf In water
20	Hosta leaf 2-5” 9small) – 1 leaf in water
	* Hosta leaves to be measured for width, not from stem to top point.
21	Rhubarb – 3 stalks
