CLASS	DESCRIPTION
1	Spray Chrysanthemum c.v.a.- 3 cuts
2	Potted Plant – Flowering in pot not over 10” diam.
3	Potted Plant – Foliage in pot not over 10” diam.
4	Cactus/ Succulent in pot not over 10” diam.
5	Collection of 5 or more succulents planted in a pot not over 10” diam.
6	African Violet -single flower
7	African Violet – double flower
8	Potted Fern – in a pot not over 10”diam.
9	A vase of Fall flowers from your garden
10	Fall Cleanup – a vase of dried plant material

11	TOPSY TURVEY – an inverted crescent
12	REMEMBER – your choice for Remembrance Day
13	BRING THE OUTSIDE IN – a round exhibit using greenery and cones only
