1	Spray Chrysanthemum – c.v.a. – 3 cuts
2	Fall Asters – c.v.a. – 3 cuts
3	Marigolds, dwarf, under 8” – c.v.a. – 3 cuts
4	Zinnias, large – c.v.a. – 3 cuts or blooms
5	Zinnias, small – c.v.a. – 3 cuts or blooms
6	Phlox – c.v.a. – 3 cuts
7	Flowering Fuchsia shrub – 1 cut
8	Perennials – 3 different in a vase
9	Gladioli – must be corm variety – 1 cut
10	Berried Shrub – 1 variety – 3 cuts
11	Sweet Peas - c.v.a. – 3 stems
12	Sunflower – present one flower on a 3 inch stem
13	Flowering shrub – (incl. roses) – 1 cut
14	Flowering hydrangea shrub – 1 cut
15	Annual or Perennial over 20” – 1 cut
16a	Grasses – c.v.a.- 3 cuts
16b	Tuberous Begonias – 3 blooms floating
17	Vegetables – 1 only of the following on a plate:
	17a – cabbage
	17b – squash
	17c – cucumber
	17d – turnip
	17e – zucchini
18	Vegetables – 3 only of the following on a plate:
	18a – carrots
	18b – onions
	18c – corn
	18d – potatoes
	18e – tomatoes
	18f – beets
	18g – beans
19	Collection of vegetables, one each of four different varieties on a plate or platter
20	Any other vegetable, not listed, on a plate – small – 3
21	Any other vegetable, not listed, on a plate – large – 1
22	Fruits – 3 only on a plate.
	22a – Pears
	22b – Plums
	22c – Apples
	22d – other fruit
	22e – Berries, 6 on a plate, with leaves
23	Nuts – 6 on a plate
