CLASS	DESCRIPTION
1	Spray Chrysanthemum – c.v.a. - 3 cuts
2	Fall Asters – c.v.a. - 3 cuts
3	Marigolds, dwarf, under 8” -c.v.a.- 3 cuts
4	Zinnias, large – c.v.a. - 3 cuts or blooms
5	Phlox, c.v.a. - 3 cuts
6	Flowering Fuchsia shrub – 1 cut
7	Perennials – 3 different in a vase
8	Gladiola – must be corm variety – 1 spike
9	Berried shrub – 1 variety – 3 cuts
10	Sweet Peas – c.v.a. 3 stems (not perennial variety)
11	Sunflower – present one bloom on a 3” stem
12	Flowering Shrub (incl. Roses) – 1 cut
13	Flowering Hydrangea shrub – 1 cut
14	Annual or Perennial over 20” – 1 cut
15	Grasses – c.v.a. - 3 cuts
16	Tuberous begonias – 3 blooms floating on bubble wrap
17	Vegetables -1 only of the following on a plate
17a	squash
17b	cucumber
17c	zucchini
18	Vegetables – 3 only of the following on a plate
18a	carrots
18b	onions
18c	tomatoes
18d	beets
18e	beans
19	Collection of vegetables, one each of four different varieties on a plate or platter
20	Any other vegetable, not listed, on a plate – small – 3
21	Any other vegetable, not listed, on a plate – large – 1
22	Fruits – 3 only on a plate
22a	Pears
22b	Plums
22c	Apples
22d	Any other fruit
22e	Berries, 6 on a plate, with leaves
23	Nuts 6 on a plate
